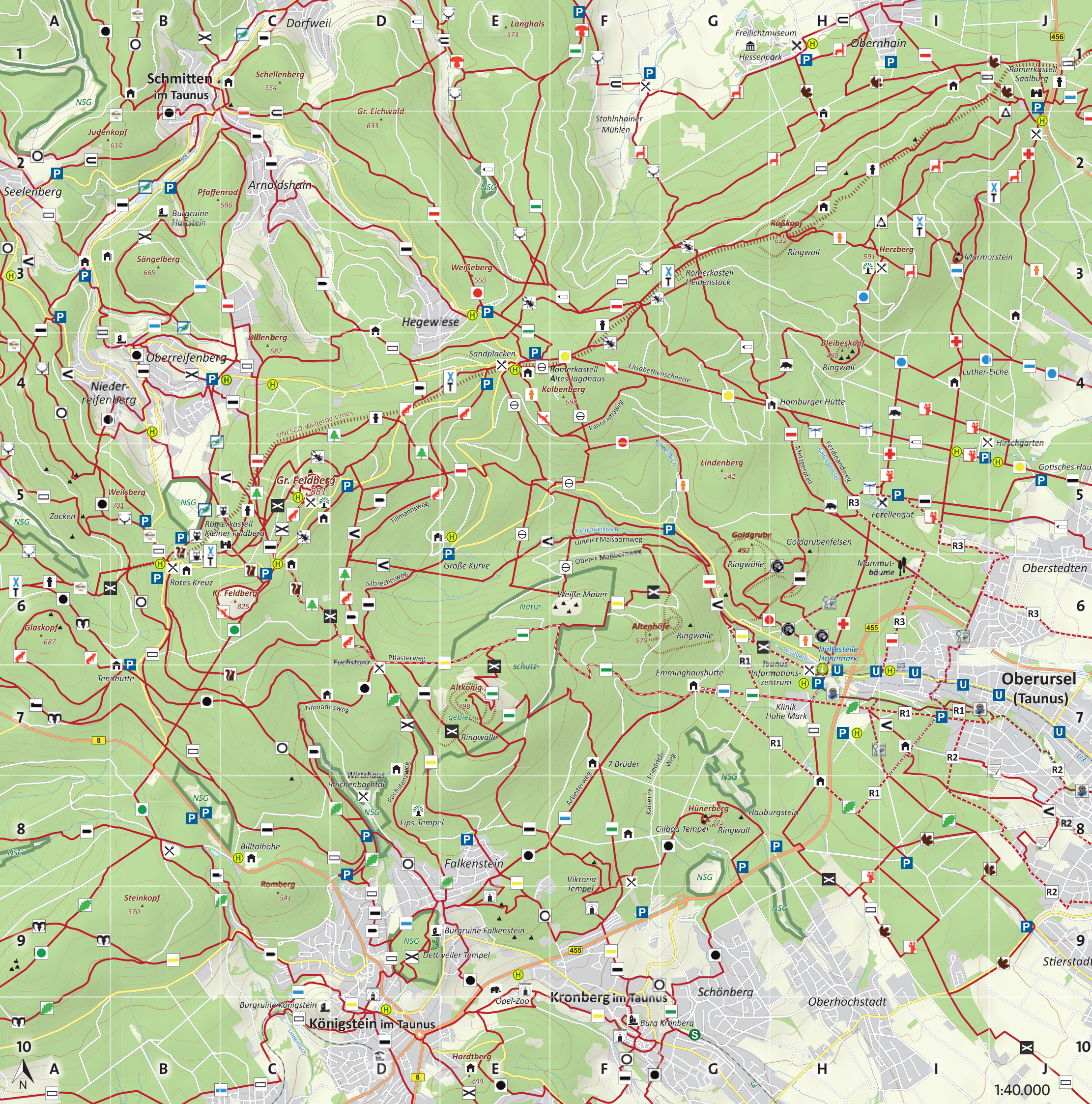

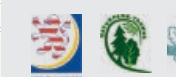
Taunus Information Centre

The first contact point for hikers, cyclists and people interested in the Taunus is located at the foot of the Großer Feldberg (Large Feldberg), at Hohemark in Oberursel, where the U3 underground train line ends: the Taunus Information Centre. Here you can find everything you need to know about discovering the most beautiful corners of the Taunus and pick up numerous maps and guides for hiking and cycling.

Circular Hiking Trails

Starting from the Taunus Information Centre*

Keltenrundwanderweg (Circular Celtic Trail)

Starting point: Bridge. Then take the second left. Partially rocky and moderate inclines.
4.3 km | Approx. 1.5-2 h



Historischer Rundweg Oberursel (Historical Circular Trail Oberursel)

Starting point: Bridge. Partially rocky and slight inclines. Can be shortened to 5 km via the Mühlenwanderweg (Mill Hiking Trail).
7.1 km | Approx. 2 h



R1 | Oberurseler Wald (Oberursel Forest)

Starting point: Parking lot. The trail mainly leads through the Oberursel Stadtwald (Municipal Forest) with slight inclines.
Approx. 10 km | Approx. 2-3 h



R2 | Maasgrund

Starting point: Bahnhof Oberursel train station. Mainly leads through the western part of town around the Maasgrund.
Approx. 8 km | Approx. 2 h



R3 | Forellengut (Trout Farm)

Starting point: Waldlust U-Bahn tube) station. Mainly runs through the Oberstedter Wald forest and north of the city.
Approx. 10 km | Approx. 2-3 h



Hiking Trails from the Taunus Information Centre* (306 m a.s.l.)

Großer Feldberg (Large Feldberg) (881 m a.s.l.)

Starting point for all four routes: Parking lot.

1) The Yellow Beam marking leads to the Fuchstanz (662 m a.s.l.). From there, follow the Red Fox marking.
Approx. 8.5 km | 2 h | 575 m altitude



2) The Red Beam marking leads directly to the Großer Feldberg (Large Feldberg).
Please note: The trail crosses the main road three times, please be careful!
Approx. 7 km | 2-2.5 h | 575 m altitude



3) The < marking leads directly to the Großer Feldberg (Large Feldberg), this trail has the lowest inclines.
Approx. 7.5 km | 2.5 h | 575 m altitude



4) Jubiläumswanderweg Taunusklub (Jubilee Hiking Trail)
First, follow the Green Beam marking to the Weiße Mauer (White Wall), then follow the Yellow Beam on the paved path towards the Fuchstanz. From Fuchstanz, the Schwarze Andreaskreuz (Black St. Andrew's Cross) leads to the Feldberg.
Approx. 10 km | 2 h | 575 m altitude



BUS 57 Schmitten-Niederreifenberg, Großer Feldberg



Altkönig (798 m a.s.l.)

Starting point: Klinik Hohe Mark. Follow the Green Beam marking towards Friedländer Straße, past the Emminghaus hut. A circular trail is possible in combination with the Yellow Beam marking. **Please note:** Not suitable for cycling.
Approx. 6-7 km | 2 h | 492 hm
Circular trail Approx. 13 km | 3-4 h | 492 hm



Fuchstanz (662 m a.s.l.)

Starting point: Parking lot. Follow the Yellow Beam marking past the Weiße Mauer (White Wall).
Approx. 6-7 km | 2 h | 356 hm



Sandplacken (669 m a.s.l.)

Starting point: Bridge. Follow the Red Dot marking. The trail is steep and narrow towards the end.
Please note: Not suitable for cycling.
Approx. 6 km | 2 h | 363 m altitude



BUS 50/51/57/245 Schmitten-Arnoldshain, Sandplacken

Römerkastell Saalburg (Roman Fort) (418 m a.s.l.)

Starting point: Bridge. Follow the Red Cross marking. Excursion to the Herzbergturm observation tower (592 m a.s.l.) is also possible by following the Blue Dot marking towards the left at the level of the Luthereiche (Luther Oak). From here, the Black Triangle leads you further to the Saalburg Roman Fort.
Approx. 8 km | 2 h
Via Herzberg approx. 9 km | 2 h | 286 m altitude
Distance to Herzberg approx. 6 km | 1.5 h | 286 m altitude

Freilichtmuseum Hessenpark (Hessenpark Open Air Museum)

(400 m a.s.l.)

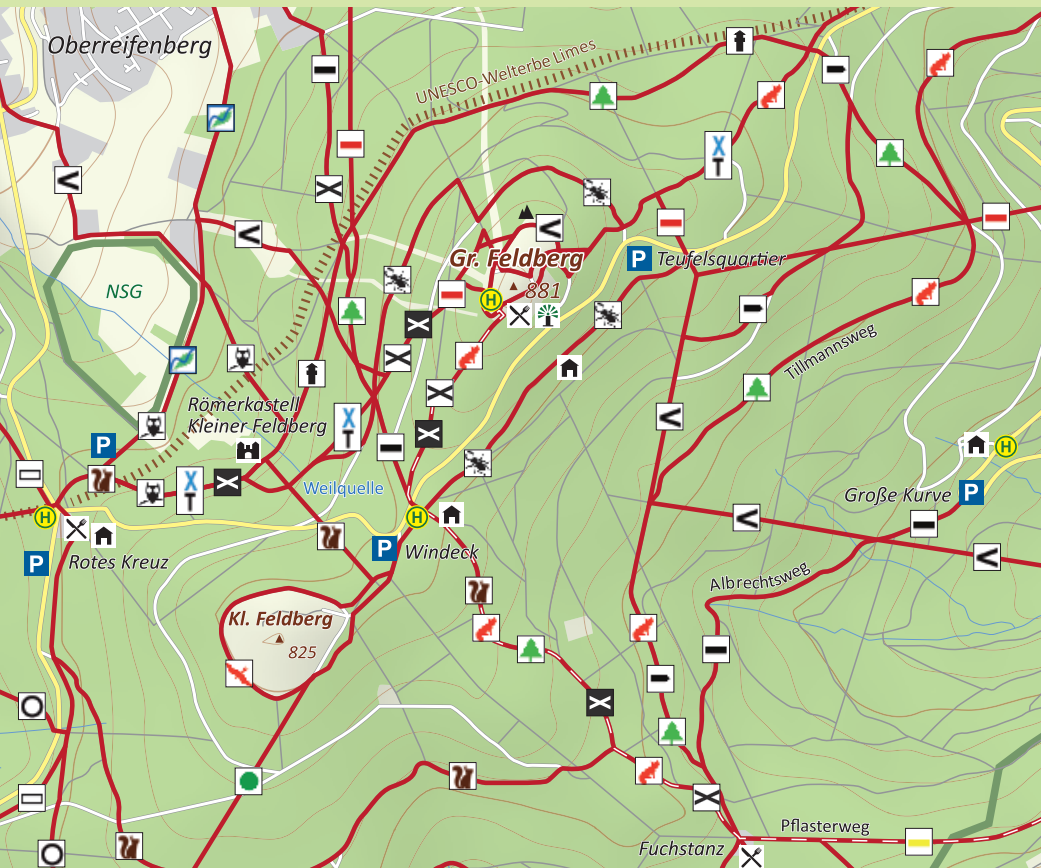
Starting point: Bridge. Follow the Red Cross marking and from the Römerkastell Saalburg (Roman Fort), follow the Taunuslehrpfad (Taunus Educational Trail) for about 3 kilometres to the Hessenpark Open Air Museum.
Approx. 11 km | 3-4 h | 286 hm (Herzberg)

Limeserlebnispfad bis zur Saalburg

(Limes Experience Trail to the Saalburg Roman Fort)

Starting point: Bridge. Take the Red Dot route to Sandplacken, the path is steep and narrow towards the end, alternatively take the bus to Sandplacken.

Approx. 6 km | 2 h | 363 m altitude

BUS 50/51/57/245 Schmitten-Arnoldshain, Sandplacken

From here, continue along the Limes Experience Trail to the Saalburg Roman Fort, marked with a stylised watchtower.

Approx. another 8 km | 2 h

BUS 5 Bad Homburg v.d.H., Saalburg



Falkenstein and Königstein Castle Ruins

Starting point: Parking lot. Follow the Yellow Beam marking past the Weiße Mauer (White Wall), the Fuchstanz (662 m a.s.l.) and the Lips Temple. In Falkenstein, take the 3BurgenWeg-trail; first to the Falkenstein Castle Ruins, then to the Königstein Castle Ruins.

Approx. 11 km to Falkenstein | 14 km to Königstein | 3-4 h
356 m altitude (Fuchstanz)

RB11/RB12 Königstein (Taunus), Bahnhof



Opel-Zoo

Starting point: Hohe Mark Clinic. Follow the Blue Beam marking towards Friedländer Straße, past the Emminghaus hut and the Sieben Brüder crossroads. On the outskirts of Falkenstein, continue along the path with the Black Beam to the Opel Zoo

Please note: The trail crosses the B455 main road, so please be careful!

Approx. 8 km | 2-3 h

BUS 261/X26/X27 Kronberg (Taunus), Opel-Zoo



Burg Kronberg (Kronberg Castle)

Starting point: Hohe Mark Klinik. Follow the Blue Beam towards Friedländer Straße, past the Emminghaus hut. At the Sieben Brüder junction, follow the Green Beam in the direction of Kronberg, then the 3BurgenWeg to Kronberg Castle.

Approx. 6-7 km | 2 h

3 Starting Points for Hikes at the Taunus Information Centre

Apart from the circular trails on the Großer Feldberg (Large Feldberg), the Kleiner Feldberg (Small Feldberg), the Rotes Kreuz (Red Cross) and the circular trails R2 and R3, all of the hikes that we recommend on this fact sheet start at the Taunus Information Centre at Hohemark in Oberursel. In detail, however, there are three different starting points where the trail markings begin: The first is at the parking lot directly at the Taunus Information Centre. The second is at the Hohe Mark Klinik, which you will reach if you walk about 150 metres into Alfred-Lechler-Strasse. The third is at the bridge 50 metres away, which takes pedestrians across the L3004 main road (Hohemarkstraße).

You can reach the Taunus Information Centre very easily by public transport:
